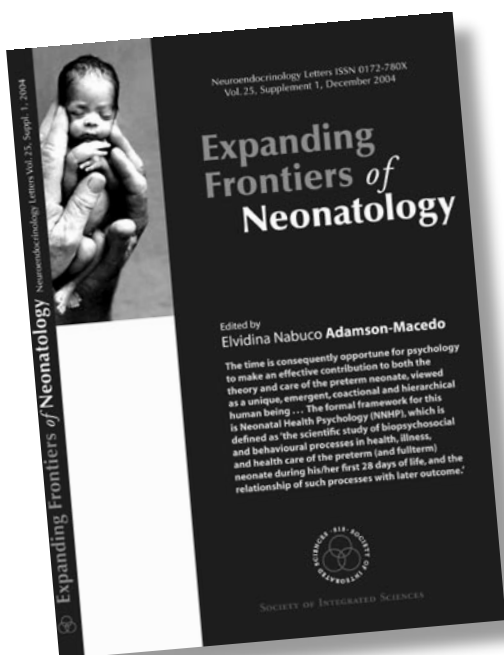
INFORMATION FROM THE OFFICE OF THE EDITOR-IN-CHIEF
